# Proposed NJBBA By Law Changes

## The By Law Currently reads -

Article 9 Jeff Paul Scholarship Fund

Section 1 Purpose

New Jersey Beach Buggy Association will establish a fund known as the Jeff Paul Scholarship Fund. Named in memory of M. Jeffries Paul. There will be two (2) awards each year in the amount of \$750.00 (seven hundred fifty) each to a member in good standing for at least two years. This applies to a members children or grandchildren to further their education. All monies in this fund will be monitored by the N.J.B.B.A. Treasurer.

# The proposed By Law change would read as follows -

Article 9 Jeff Paul Scholarship Fund

Section 1 Purpose

New Jersey Beach Buggy Association will establish a fund known as the Jeff Paul Scholarship Fund. Named in memory of M. Jeffries Paul. There will be two (2) awards each year in the amount of **\$1000.00** (one thousand) each to a member in good standing for at least two years. This applies to a members **spouse**, children or grandchildren to further their education. All monies in this fund will be monitored by the N.J.B.B.A. Treasurer.

# The By Law Currently reads -

**ARTICLE 7 By-Laws** 

Section 1 Amendments

The meeting where the proposed by-law changes are to be voted shall be properly advertised to all members in writing either by the N.J.B.B.A. News or by a special meeting noting such and sent at least seven (7) days prior to such meeting.






# TRS FISHING INDIANS

Chris Farrell, my dad, NJBBA #30 passed away on December 11, 2022. Chris started fishing in Seaside Park in the early 1970's with his first beach buggy, a 1966 Ford Bronco. In 1977, he bought his first pickup with a camper, a 1969 Ford with a Phoenix camper. He not only loved surf fishing, he also fabricated many cooler racks, back porches, custom sand spikes, and other accessories over the years. He took meticulous care of his equipment, servicing and lubricating his reels each year and replacing worn internal parts when needed, and using his 1969 Ford into the late 90's. He used many of the same rods and reels he started out with his entire time fishing. He also built most of the surf rods that he used from blanks, and often made repairs for others, replacing a guide, reel seat, or tip. He tied most of his own rigs, replaced worn hooks on lures, and took care of everything he owned.

Dad was always willing to help someone in need. One legendary story happened in the early 80's at the NJBBA Great Fall Classic in Wildwood. Matt D'Agostino fell asleep in his camper when the tide came in. The water was up to the hood of his truck, and the truck would not start. With a very heavy Phoenix camper on his own truck, Chris rigged a towline to Matt's truck (getting soaking wet in the process), then another towline to a second rig. Working together, the two trucks were able to break Matt's truck free from the suction where his tires had sunken into the sand underwater. After pulling him out of the surf, he helped take apart the carburetor on Matt's truck and got it running again for him on the spot.

Many years ago, he met a random guy fishing in the evening named Ben. Ben had parked at A-8, walked over and had a large plug bag full of brand new nice lures. He was just starting out surf fishing and was asking for advice and information. Later that evening while walking back up the beach, Ben was devastated. Somehow, he had lost his plug bag, possibly by setting it down when a large wave came in. Chris told him, "I'll bet it will wash back up at low tide". Disappointed, Ben left. At 2 am the following morning, with nobody around at dead low tide, Chris got up and drove his camper on the "low beach" from A-7 south. Sure enough, he found the bag. He went to the gatehouse, office, told the park ranger, and even made a handwritten note on a piece of cardboard that said "Ben, I found it" with his phone number and stapled it to the sign at A-8. He made every possible effort to return it, that is just who he was.

You could always tell when he was around by his hearty and loud laughter. He always loved Island Beach, and part of him will always be there.


