



2011 NJBBA Surf Fishing Team

The NJBBA surf fishing team has had a productive year in 2011. Taking 2nd place this year, 4th place in 2010, and 5th place in 2009 ASAC standings. The current standings and points for 2011 are as follows: Surf & Land with 143 pts, **NJBBA** with 123 pts, South Jersey Surfcasters with 120 pts, Fishin Fuzz with 105 pts, and the Women's Surf Fishing Club with 98 pts. Team NJBBA, consist of members Kevin & Lynda Greaves, Kurt Renart, Ralph Delucca, Boli Mam, Joe McGowan and alternates Tim Burden and Kurt Renart Jr. This is a new team with drive and motivation to win, with absolute dedication to the team and each other. They all have had their good days and off days, but what still remains, is their drive to keep fishing till the end. Each member takes care of each other when it comes to bait, equipment, rigs and transportation to each event.

Individual scores for 2011 the team started out ok participating in three spring tournaments taking 3rd place in the Delaware Valley Surf Association Tournament which put the team in 5th place at the start of the fall tournaments. In the South Jersey Surfcasters Tournament NJBBA took 2nd place and then another 2nd place at the Ocean City Fishing Club Tournament. They then finish in 8th place at the LBI Tournament. The next tournament was Pennsauken Fishing Club, in which the NJBBA fishing team took top honors, for their first win of 2011. The next competition was the NJBBA's Great Fall Classic, since we host this tournament the team could not participate, but did help by being Judges. Then at the Hudson River Tournament they took 4th place proceeded by the teams second 1st place finish at the Women's Surf Fishing Club Tournament. All in all, the entire team fished hard and fished till the end. Everyone has stepped up to the plate to do what they could for the team.

Individual stats for the team..... member Ralph Delucca took 1st place largest fish and 2nd place most fish at South Jersey Surfcasters tourney and 1st place largest fish at Ocean City Fishing Club, which will win him 1st place largest fish points for the year. Those finishes have earned him an ASAC jacket and plaque commemorating his accomplishments. Boli Mam won 1st place most fish points at Pennsauken Fishing Club which carried the team to a win at the event. Lynda Greaves won the women's division for largest fish with a 2nd place at Delaware Valley, Ocean City, Pennsauken, Women's Surf and a 1st place at Hudson River which has earned her an ASAC jacket and plaque as well. Lynda also took 2nd place in the women's division for most fish points with a 3rd place at Delaware Valley and a 1st place at Ocean City, Pennsauken and Women's Surf which will win her a plaque. The entire NJBBA Team is looking forward to the 2012 fishing competition.
