#### Proposed NJBBA By Law Change

#### The By Law Currently reads -

ARTICLE 9 Jeff Paul Scholarship Fund

Section 1 Purpose

"The New Jersey Beach Buggy Association will establish a fund known as the Jeff Paul Scholarship Fund. Named in memory of M. Jefferies Paul. There will be two (2) awards each year in the amount of \$750 (seven hundred fifty) to member or member's children to further their education. All monies in this fund will be monitored by the NJBBA Treasurer."

#### The proposed By Law change would read as follows -


ARTICLE 9 Jeff Paul Scholarship Fund

Section 1 Purpose

The New Jersey Beach Buggy Association will establish a fund known as the Jeff Paul Scholarship Fund. Named in memory of M. Jefferies Paul. <u>Two \$750 NJBBA</u> scholarships will be available to be awarded each year. To be eligible for the award a member must be in good standing of NJBBA for two consecutive years. <u>The member, member's spouse, member's children or member's grandchildren are all eligible to apply for the educational scholarship as a NJBBA membership benefit.</u> All monies in this fund will be monitored by the NJBBA Treasurer.

#### FISHING INDIANS






## Circle Hooks for Striped Bass

In 2021, a new regulation requires using inline circle hooks when fishing for striped bass using cut or whole natural baits like clams, squid, mackerel, menhaden, seaworms, or eels. Using inline circle hooks significantly increases survival of released striped bass by reducing occurrences of gut hooking.

#### What's a circle hook?

Unlike a J-shaped hook, on an inline circle hook the point curves back toward the shank.







If a striped bass swallows your bait, the circle hook will slide out from its throat and catch on the corner of its jaw. The circle hook sets itself when the fish tries to swim away.

#### How do I use a circle hook?

When a fish takes your bait, do not sweep the rod upward to set the hook! Instead, simply let the line come tight and fight the fish.



#### What if I gut-hook a fish?

When using circle hooks, you may occasionally gut-hook a fish. If this happens, cut the leader as close as you can to the hook and leave it in the fish.

#### **New Jersey Beach Buggy Association Code of Ethics**

- To enter and leave beaches in prescribed ways.
- To eliminate speeding and reckless driving.
- To respect local ordinances and the rights of property owners.
- To offer aid to any fisherman or buggy owner in trouble on the beach.
- To respect picnicking and bathing groups by: (a) avoiding them whenever possible; (b) by slowing to minimum speed when passing picnicking or bathing groups.
- To avoid littering the beach with trash, cans, etc.. by using trash barrels when available, or by taking it with you when leaving the area.
- To avoid over-crowding any one area and elbowing other anglers out of their chosen spots. This is particularly important where surf men without buggies are concentrated.
- To leave the track when a halt is made, so that other buggies will not be forced to detour.
- To fill in holes after getting stuck, and to avoid indiscriminately crisscrossing tracks.
- To observe the rules of common courtesy on the beach.
- Simplify passing of vehicles meeting head-on in a single track: The driver who has the dunes on his right will be required to turn out of the track to the right. This rule to be tempered with common sense in difficult circumstances.
- To ask those who park their gear in the middle of the track if they will move it and explain in a courteous manner why.
- Do not drive at night without lights, but when approaching fishermen, drive behind them and avoid shining lights on fishermen and water.
- To realize that fishing is a God-given sport and to keep it on a high plane so that others may enjoy it as well
